DAY - 40% CHANGE SCATTERED THUNDERSTORMS. HIGH NEAR 76. HUMIDITY 72%. WINDS SW AT 7 MPH NIGHT - LOW NEAR 55. HUMIDITY 96%. WINDS SSW AT 5 MPH.

SUNDAY

DAY - SUNNY. HIGH NEAR 85. HUMIDITY 61%. WINDS SSW AT 16 MPH NIGHT - LOW NEAR 54. HUMIDITY 76%. WINDS WSW AT 8 MPH.

MONDAY

DAY - SUNNY. HIGH NEAR 89. HUMIDITY 533%. WINDS SW AT 8 MPH NIGHT - LOW NEAR 60. HUMIDITY 95%. WINDS S AT 5 MPH.

TUESDAY

DAY - SUNNY. HIGH NEAR 85. HUMIDITY 553%. WINDS SSW AT 18 MPH NIGHT - LOW NEAR 60. HUMIDITY 72%. WINDS S AT 15 MPH.

WEDNESDAY

DAY - 50% CHANCE SCATTERED THUNDERSTORMS IN MORNING. HIGH NEAR 79. HUMIDITY 503%. WINDS SW AT 11 MPH

Individual Packing List

- * extra shoes for canoeing Sunday and Monday (CROCS, Keens, etc. Water shoes)

Class A Uniform (worn Tuesday for National Scout Museum)

Clothes for Wednesday

Sleeping clothes

Extra set of clothes

Medium trash bag for wet, dirty clothes

Small sling backpack or fanny pack

* large enough to carry rain gear, water bottle, sunscreen, bug spray and some trail food.

Poncho or rain gear

Water bottle/canteen

Sunscreen

Bug spray - 30% DEET minimum, preferred

Hat

Pocket knife

Mess kit, utensils & cup

Flashlight/batteries

Tooth brush and paste

Comb/brush

Soap

Washcloth / towel

Sleeping bag and liner or extra blanket

Sleeping pad

Ground cloth

First aid kit

Inexpensive camera, stored in a couple of Ziploc bags for water protection.
