Summer Camp preparations have begun. Adults, your commitment to attend Summer Camp is needed. **You should have received an email from the troop containing an**

attachment in which you can download an Adult Summer Camp Application in PDF form where you can type in your data and then print it off and bring it to Scout Meeting. Contact Mr. Phy on Monday and let him know you plan on helping with Summer Camp. We will prepare our course offerings from the adults who sign-up to go and teach classes. **We can only offer classes we have instructors for.** We will begin our Summer Camp registration in May. We would like to start filling out the “**Blue Sheets**” on **May 11.** Scouters will meet with the Scouts and help them sign-up for Summer Camp and review their class selections. **We need ALL our adults to go to Summer Camp!!!.**

We are planning to conduct the **Summer Camp Physical exams night on May 18, 2015.** Dr. Suzy Liner has graciously agreed to let us use her clinic, The Allergy & Asthma Clinic of West Texas located at 3502-22nd, for the physicals. **We will begin at 6:00pm and go until 7:30pm.** Physicals will be performed by the physicians who are members of our troop. **The BSA Physical Form must be used.** We will share a link to the BSA

Physical from. Please fill out the form and print it off and bring it with you along with a copy of your medical insurance card. The cost of the physical is \$5.00 per person. Everyone, Scout and Scouter that is a member of our troop will need to have a physical. Physicals are required on an annual basis.

Advancement Update

Scouts and Scouters, here is the information on how you can check a Scouts advancement records. Go to the Troop web site (www.troop157.com) and

locate the link in the top left section of the home page or you can go to:

<http://www.troopmasterweb.com/troop157>.

You will need a User ID and a Password to get into the system. The User ID is the scout's last name first initial (Joe Smith would be SmithJ). The Password will be the scout's six digit birthday (01/01/2000 would be 010100). Once you are in the system you will be able to change the password. This tool will let you pull up the most up to date scout records. All scouts should be responsible for keeping track of their own rank advancement progress and parents should encourage them to check
