BSA Summer Camp Physicals.

Dr. Liner has offered her clinic for the evening. **The BSA form must be used and can be found on the troop website.** Parents, fill out the personal information and bring the printed form for the Dr.s to finish. If you need physicals for sports or school, bring those form along as well. You do not have to use this night to get your physical. Your family doctor can perform the exam, but realize that the **BSA form must be used for the troop.** Even if you are not able to go to Summer Camp, all Scouts and Scouters need the annual BSA physical to participate in troop activities. **We will be at the Allergy and Asthma Clinic of West Texas. 3502-22nd Street. Scouts and Scouters, here is the information on how you can check a Scouts advancement records. Go to the Troop web site

(www.troop157.com) and locate the link in the top left section of the home page or you can go to <http://www.troopmasterweb.com/troop157>. You will need a **User ID** and a **Password** to get into the system. The **User ID** is the scout's last name first initial (Joe Smith would be SmithJ). The **Password** will be the scout's six digit birthday (01/01/2000 would be 010100). Once you are in the system you will be able to change the password. This tool will let you pull up the most up to date scout records.
